All of our accommodation offers en suite rooms, suitable for undergraduate and postgraduate students, apart from University Locks two bedroom flats which has shared facilities.

For students with special requirements we have accessible purpose-built rooms at some of the halls of residence. Further information is available on request.

Why choose halls of residence?

Please note there may be some minor variations on each campus.

- 24/7 security personnel patrol the campuses.
- CCTV on all campuses.
- Heating in all rooms.
- Energy costs included in accommodation fees (some are capped in some partner provider halls and further charges could be incurred).
- Free basic package internet connection socket and wi-fi (upgrades are available).
- Accommodation staff available on all campuses during office hours.
- Central management of all University halls of residence by Accommodation Services.
- Accommodation
 Services' commitment to quality.

What can you expect in your accommodation?

While there are some minor variations on each campus, a standard room is furnished with:

- bed, mattress and mattress cover (you will need to bring your own bed linen)
- curtains/blind
- wardrobe
- chest of drawers
- bookshelf
- study desk and chair
- mirror.

The majority of self-catering kitchens are equipped with the following:

- electric cooker
- fridge/freezer
- microwave
- kettle
- ironing board.

Each site has its own launderette.

Am I eligible for accommodation?

Students are guaranteed a room in University Partner halls of residence for their first year, close to their location of study providing they:

- have received and accepted an offer on a full-time course at Birmingham City University
- live further than 10 miles from their place of study (check BCU Accommodation website postcode validation facility - www.bcu.ac.uk/ student-info/accommodation/apply)
- have applied for accommodation by 31 July 2018.

We are able to assist with accommodation to new undergraduate students if Birmingham City University is your Insurance choice or you are admitted to the University through the Clearing process subject to availability of rooms, and having taken into account the location of your permanent home address in relation to the place of study. If we are able to assist, you must apply online by 31 August 2018.

Students who live within a 10-mile radius of the study campus may be offered accommodation at the end of the allocation process (this is subject to availability).

We regret that it is not possible for us to guarantee a room at your preferred location. On-campus accommodation is normally given to students whose courses are based on or close to the campus in question subject to availability.

When can I apply for accommodation?

You are able to apply for accommodation through the online accommodation application process from March 2018 provided you have accepted an unconditional or conditional offer of a course at Birmingham City University.

- Closing date for applications for UK students is 31 July 2018.
- Closing date for applications for EU/ International students is 31 August 2018.

How do I apply for accommodation?

Please view the range of accommodation and identify your preferences before making an application. The accommodation room offer policy can be found on our website along with lots of useful information.

Please read through the details in this booklet and visit www.bcu.ac.uk/ accommodation. If you have any unanswered questions after doing so, please contact Accommodation Services by email on accommodation@bcu.ac.uk. Or you can call the team on 0121 331 5191.

If you have a disability or if there are medical or mobility factors which have a bearing on your accommodation needs, please provide full details and supporting evidence at the time of application to enable us to allocate appropriately. You should also contact the Disability Services team in Student Affairs for advice and assistance on 0121 331 5588 or you can visit their website at www.bcu.ac.uk/disability.

To apply for accommodation you will need to:

- visit our website at www.bcu.ac.uk/accommodation
- view the applications section
- click the 'apply now' button
- complete the application form; you will need your University Application Number which can be found on the offer paperwork from your Faculty (it has eight numeric characters)
- Please use the notes section of the application form to advise us of any additional information for example if you plan to be away and will not have access to the internet as this will help avoid any delays.

NB: to avoid any delay please ensure you frequently check the progress of your online application. You will only have three days to accept your room offer.

When will I know if I have been allocated accommodation?

Allocation of rooms will commence from:

- 3 April 2018 for all students holding an accepted Unconditional Firm offer (UF).
- August 2018 for all students awaiting exam results.

You will receive an email from Accommodation Services informing you that you have been offered accommodation. Please follow the instructions set out in the email to accept your offer. Further details will be provided regarding the payment arrangements.

At the point you are offered a room, you will be required to either make a £350 advance payment or £250 deposit - depending on the accommodation you have been allocated to.

University Locks

You will be able to move into your accommodation during the weekend before your course starts and your Licence Agreement indicates the date from which you will be liable for the Residence Fees. Please note that the accommodation will not be available any earlier than the start of the Licence Agreement.

Before you are able to move into your allocated accommodation, you will be requested to complete the online welcome. You will receive an email with instructions on how to complete this process. The online welcome will include additional important information that you will require:

- Useful information regarding your stay in accommodation and arrival instructions.
- Things you need to bring with you which are not supplied within the accommodation.


Curzon Gateway, Jennens Court, The Heights and Belgrave View
