



## **Connecting to Eduroam via Windows 8**

The following instructions are intended for users who wish to connect to the eduroam wireless network using Microsoft Windows 8.

## **Instructions**

1. Open the Windows 8 Charms bar pop-out menu, by moving the mouse cursor to either right-hand corner of the screen, or by alternatively using the Windows+C short-cut key combination. Open the [Network and Sharing Center] by selecting [Settings] and typing: "network and sharing center" in the search bar (Figure 1).






Figure 2 Figure 3

2. Select [Set up a new connection or network] (Figure 2), followed by [Manually connect to a wireless network] (Figure 3).

3. Enter the information as shown in (Figure 4). Network name: "eduroam", Security Type: "WPA2-Enterprise" Encryption Type: "AES".



4. Click [Next] and you will be prompted with a message to say you have successfully added "eduroam" (Figure 5). Now select the option to [Change connection settings], you will be presented with a window called [Wireless Network Properties]. Where it says [choose a network authentication method] select [Microsoft: Protected EAP (PEAP)] (Figure 6).







Figure 7 Figure 8

5. Click the **[Settings]** button. In the new window that appears, check the first two options as shown in (Figure 7), and enter the server name: **[radius.bcu.ac.uk]**. Next click **[configure]** and <u>uncheck</u> the option for **[Automatically use my Windows Logon name and Password]** and click **[ok]**.






Figure 9 Figure 10

6. Click **[ok]** through the menus to save your settings. Locate and open the **[Connect to a network]** by selecting **[Settings]** and typing: "network and sharing center" in the search bar (Figure 9). From the list of available networks select "eduroam" and click **[Connect]** (Figure 10).

7. Click [Connect] and the eduroam wireless network will prompt you to authenticate (Figure 11).




