#### **Prize Draw Terms & Conditions**

Birmingham City University is launching a prize draw for updating your alumni details for the chance to win £50 worth of High Street Vouchers, The closing date for entries is 5pm on Wednesday 31st January 2018 and is subject to the terms and conditions below.

# 1. Promoter:

# 2. Eligibility:

The prize draw is only open to alumni from Birmingham City University.

The prize draw is not open to employees of Birmingham City University, its subsidiaries and or any affiliates, suppliers and or any member of their immediate families.

Birmingham City University reserves the right to disqualify any entrant and/or winner in their absolute discretion for any reason and without notice.

# **Competition Rules for Entrants:**

- Only one entry will be accepted from each entrant
- There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter this competition
- No cash alternative to the prizes will be offered. The prizes are not transferable
- The competition is open to Birmingham City University alumni who update their details with the Alumni Association either on the form provided with the alumni magazine or online
- Birmingham City University reserves the right to cancel or amend the competition and these terms and conditions without notice
- Entrants' data (comprising name and university email address) will be collected, stored, and processed for the purposes of administering and assessing this Prize Draw
- The prize draw runs until 5pm on Wednesday, 31st January 2018 and any entries received after this time will not be entered into the prize draw

#### 3. Promotion Period:

The closing date for entries is 5pm on Wednesday, 31st January 2018 and any entries received after this time will not be entered into the prize draw. Birmingham City University reserves the right to extend the entry period.

# 4. How to Enter:

Entrants must return the 'update your details' form either by returning the paper form provided with the alumni magazine and sending it back to the Alumni Association or by completing the online 'update your details' form at www.bcu.ac.uk/update-us. No purchase or payment is required.

#### 5. Limitation of entries:

Only one entry per eligible alumni will be accepted. Automated entries, bulk entries or third party entries will be disqualified.

### 6. Prize:

Three prizes of £50 worth of 'high street' gift vouchers.

Birmingham City University is responsible for administering the prize. Please contact alumni@bcu.ac.uk if you have any queries.



The prize is as stated and no alternative prize or cash substitute will be offered.

The High Street vouchers must be used within any terms and conditions and any specified time limit, after which the prize will become invalid. Any additional products or services not included in the prize, but required, will need to be arranged and paid for by the winner. In the event for any reason the prize winner does not spend the High Street vouchers or an element of them by any the time limit stipulated, then the prize will be forfeited by the winner and neither cash nor any other form of compensation will be supplied in lieu of that element of the prize.

Birmingham City University assumes no responsibility and is not liable for any costs, charges or expenses which winners may be required to pay at any time in connection to any prize.

No transfer or assignment of prizes will be permitted except by Birmingham City University.

Birmingham City University reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value.

#### 7. The Draw:

Winners will be determined by a random draw conducted by the alumni team at Birmingham City University from all eligible entries. If an ineligible entry is drawn it will be automatically void and a further draw made.

The draw will be witnessed by an observer independent of the alumni team conducting the draw.

The draw will be conducted within fourteen working days from the closing date.

Birmingham City University reserve the right to postpone the draw until a later date should the prize draw period be extended. All decisions are final and binding.

#### 8. Notification:

Winners will be notified by email within seven days of the date of the draw. Notification will be sent to the winner's email address. Winners will then be asked to confirm a postal address to send the prize by post. Winners will be sent their prize via post within 14 days of supplying their details to Birmingham City University. Birmingham City University accepts no responsibility for any lost prizes.

A prize is awarded conditionally on acceptance and must be claimed by the winner within 7 days from the point of notification that they are a winner. If winners do not confirm acceptance and or do not provide a postal address within 7 days of the notification the prize will be deemed as unclaimed or unaccepted and an alternative winner may be chosen at random at the sole discretion of Birmingham City University.

If a prize is unclaimed or declined, the prize will be deemed as unclaimed or unaccepted and an alternative winner may be chosen at random at the sole discretion of Birmingham City University.

If for any reason any aspect of this competition is not capable of running as planned, or in the event of any fraud, abuse or error effective the proper operation of this prize draw Birmingham City University in its sole discretion may cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition including, amending these terms and conditions and declaring void any winner notifications already issued



# 9. Use of your personal information:

Birmingham City University will use entrants personal data for the following purposes:

- 1. All entrants' data (comprising name and contact email address) will be collected, stored, and processed for the purposes of administering and assessing this Prize Draw;
- 2. Names and contact email addresses will be used for the purpose of contacting winners of the prize draw;
- 3. Personal data used for the purpose of the prize draw will not be given to any third party;
- 4. Personal data included in the 'updated your details' submission forms will be used to update the university alumni data base and your contact preferences. The data will be for the purposes as set out in the Alumni Privacy Notice available at www.bcu.ac.uk/privacy.

# 10. Liability:

Birmingham City University is not responsible for late, lost, misdirected, mechanically reproduced, mis-delivered, incomplete, illegible, or unintelligible entries, messages or post; unavailable network connections; failed, incomplete, garbled, or delayed computer transmission; on line failures; hardware software or other technical malfunctions or disturbances; or any other communications failures or circumstances affecting, disrupting or corrupting the prize draw in any manner.

Birmingham City University is not responsible for any inaccuracy in the contact details supplied by the participant that may result in the inability of Birmingham City University to contact that participant.
